- Jessica Western (RI) facilitated group introductions
- Jessica Western (RI) gave an introduction and brief overview of the day's discussion
  - Go through, as a group, the initial considerations and feedback for policies that were received from the stakeholder group and make any adjustments or modifications
  - Answer questions included in the initial considerations
  - Discuss additional considerations the group may have regarding additional topics to be addressed in this or a future revision of the standards
  - Discuss next steps in the stakeholder process and working group process
- Lindsay Patterson went through each of the considerations included in the spreadsheets for "implementation policies"
  - Asked for additional feedback, refinements, answered questions that arose
- Additional Input and Considerations

- Contaminants of Emerging Concern
  - PFAS/PFOA
    - Starting to find these compounds in surface waters of the state
  - Microplastics
  - Pharmaceuticals
- Nutrients
- DEQ should also consider input received during the prior public comment period
- Designated Uses
  - Backcountry designated use is not necessary if captured within the primary contact use
  - Need additional time to flesh out a Wild and Scenic River use
- Rule Revision Process
  - Support for bringing proposed rules back to this group
  - Support for more and different meeting locations
    - Gina explained that the Water and Waste Advisory Board dictates meeting locations during that process
- Next Steps
  - Stakeholder Process Report
    - Ruckelshaus Institute will be drafting a report that summarizes the stakeholder process and the deliverables associated with the process
    - Draft report will be sent to the stakeholder group for review and input, prior to being finalized
    - Report will become part of the rule revision record
  - Rule Revision Process and Draft Proposed Rules
    - DEQ will draft proposed revisions, conduct an internal review that includes Attorney General's Office
      - This may require a substantial amount of time due to the substantive nature of the changes
    - DEQ will obtain EPA input on proposed revisions to ensure consistency with the federal Clean Water Act
    - DEQ will share proposed revisions with the stakeholder group, either during a formal public comment period for the Water and Waste Advisory Board or prior to the Water and Waste Advisory Board
- Evaluation Form
  - Jessica Western sent an evaluation form to the working group to complete and send back to Lindsay
  - Evaluation will assist DEQ and RI with future stakeholder processes
